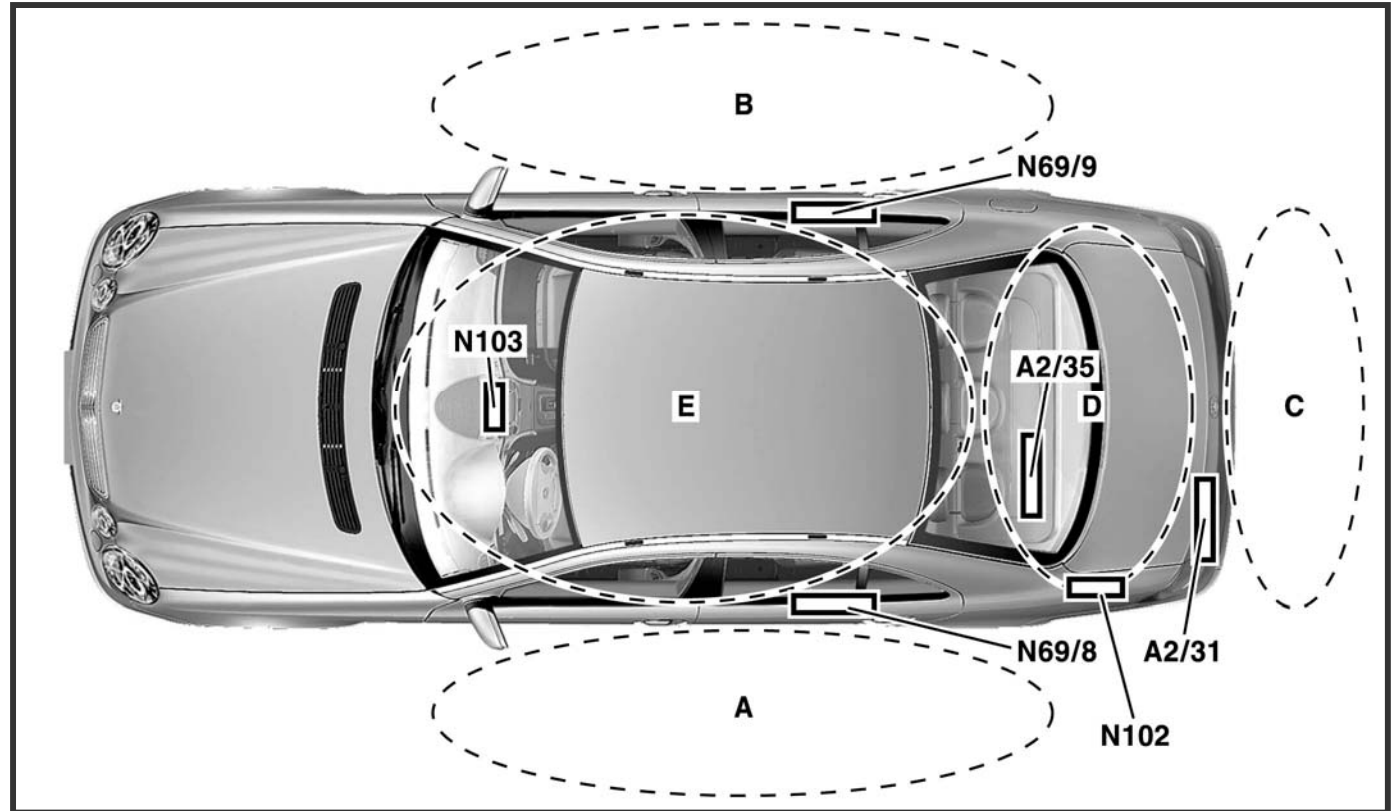

- Locking
- Convenience closing of windows and roof
- Unlocking
- Arming and disarming the alarm
- Switching on accessory circuits without starting engine
- Starting engine
- Stopping engine

Advantages of KG

- Keyless operation
- Unlikely that owner will be locked out of vehicle with KG key left inside
